Dear RM,

Receive our greetings once again in Jesus our Messiah. We are doing well and the work is prospering. I take this opportunity to thank you for your support and prayers. Your support is very important not only to us but also to the students of the word who are benefitting with the three angels message, health messages and humanitarian assistance. God has been faithful, God enabled us buy medicines for treating jiggers and pesticide for spraying bedbugs. This week we have been treating our fellow brethren and the students of the Word who have been affected by jiggers and on Wednesday we sprayed bedbugs.

It's also good to clarify that our focus and duty has been to present the three angels messages. Presenting this message will forever remain in our hearts. Taking care of the needs and treatments we are sometimes doing is just a project under/within evangelism we are doing only if extra resources are available. But our main focus is evangelism and bible teachings. We are still using radios to communicate end time truth. We are still running bible study classes and still maintain and encourage Sabbath keeping home churches. As we continue to run these bible study/teaching programs, we are recruiting more bible workers to help us reach different regions and their villages. On Monday, Brothers Kennedy, and Ashton and I, were on the field teach the word of God and also treating jiggers. People sees us differently, because we are not only teaching the word for free and giving books, but also sometimes spending on treating them and buying some few blankets and small shopping to the less fortunate families.

This is one of our Sabbath meetings. All souls in this photo keep the Sabbath holy. Some did not come because of health challenges. We have rented one of the rooms behind for Sabbath meetings and weekly bible study classes.



This is another house we have gotten and we will be sharing with them once a week. They are brother Dominic Wanami, sister Gloria and their daughter. The study was about "Sunday is not a day of worship", and how was Sunday brought in Christianity by the little horn power.



This meeting happened on Monday. This group fellowship at Maranatha church. Their foundation is just bad. They worship on Sunday, baptize and believe in the trinity, and they believe in salvation by faith which to them means not keeping the laws, people burning in hell etc. The man with a hat on is an evangelist of this Maranatha church and he has two wives because his Maranatha church allows him. Our stand on truth is firm and we started by exposing errors in their denomination. They have called for every Monday for bible study classes. From this group, we treated two people who have been affected by jiggers.



These are two people who have been affected by jiggers, a mother and her son. The house behind is where the mother stays. Sorry, our camera did not take the whole house only a quarter.



This group is one of bible classes we are running. The number has been reducing but we thank God for the few faithful ones who are still eager to learn and to be taught. Our study was about two choices/No middle ground. But it is a community that has been affected by jiggers.





We then treated jiggers. This is what jiggers do to a person.



After cleaning and removing jiggers, we then dip their legs inside treated water. Legs will stay inside treated water for half an hour. During this time, remaining jiggers will suffocate and die and their eggs will also die.

Apart from teaching the word, our desire is also to see people healthy and happy. These families are happy with what we are doing to them. It means a lot to them. When they are affected by jiggers, they get isolated and discriminated.

We give glory to God. In total, we treated eight souls since Monday. The radios are active and Kennedy and I are still teaching the Word in the radios every Fridays. Our country's economy is really bad and life has really gone up, continue to pray for us. May God abundantly bless the entire Restitution Ministry. Shalom.

Wrote on my white board the following in Korean, "Pleasure lovers are still crowding to theaters, horse races, gambling hells. The highest excitement prevails, yet probation's hour is fast closing, and every case is about to be eternally decided." Then as a Korean learner asked people at a freeway rest stop area if there are horse race tracks and gambling places in Korea. They said "yea one race track in Seoul and one legal gambling place near Sokcho". I wrote everything in blue letters but " probation's hour" in green letters. The goal was to have them wonder what "probation's hour" means.

Had some nice conversations with the smokers telling them that the Most high God helped me to quit and that He will help them too! They gladly take tracts.

About 5 months back we had a 3 day forest fire within view of our house. (See pictures) So now there are little white cars with red flags driving around warning people about forest fires . Stopped to talk with one of these red flag drivers. He told me his



sister died a few years ago from eating pork. So told him you know the Bible says not to eat pork, he said oh that is just a parable, then i said no just a moment and ran to my truck to get my sword and we opened to Lev 11. We read how God tells us not to eat camel coney hare and swine flesh. He was surprised. We studied about the signs of the times and the return of Jesus. We talked about the ginseng field in front of us while talking. They like shade(see pics) Here is the one quote in the SOP about growing in the shade.

"It would seem that the ladies have a particular dislike for the sunlight, for they remain most of the time shut in from its influence, with curtains closed to keep it from fading the carpets, while for the want of it they themselves fade and become weak and sickly, like the plants which grow in the shade, and are never kissed, and colored, and strengthened, by the life-giving rays of the sun. If perchance they venture out into the open air and sunlight, they dare not go without carrying a shade to keep the sun from tanning their 'Lily-White' cheeks, just as though pale and sickly looking countenances were more beautiful and desirable than those which are ever blooming with the fresh, clear, and sparkling hues of health. {HR April 1, 1871, par. 13}

Sunlight is one of the best tonics and beautifiers in the world; therefore, men, women, and children, one and all, should seek it as one of the great natural agencies which help to form the 'elixir of life.'" {HR April 1, 1871, par. 14}

Today in Ok Chun set up my white board at a college in front of a pagoda then asked the students what the Chinese writing was on the pagoda? Have found out the method of Jesus is the best to meet strangers and strike up a conversation. A favor and a question.
