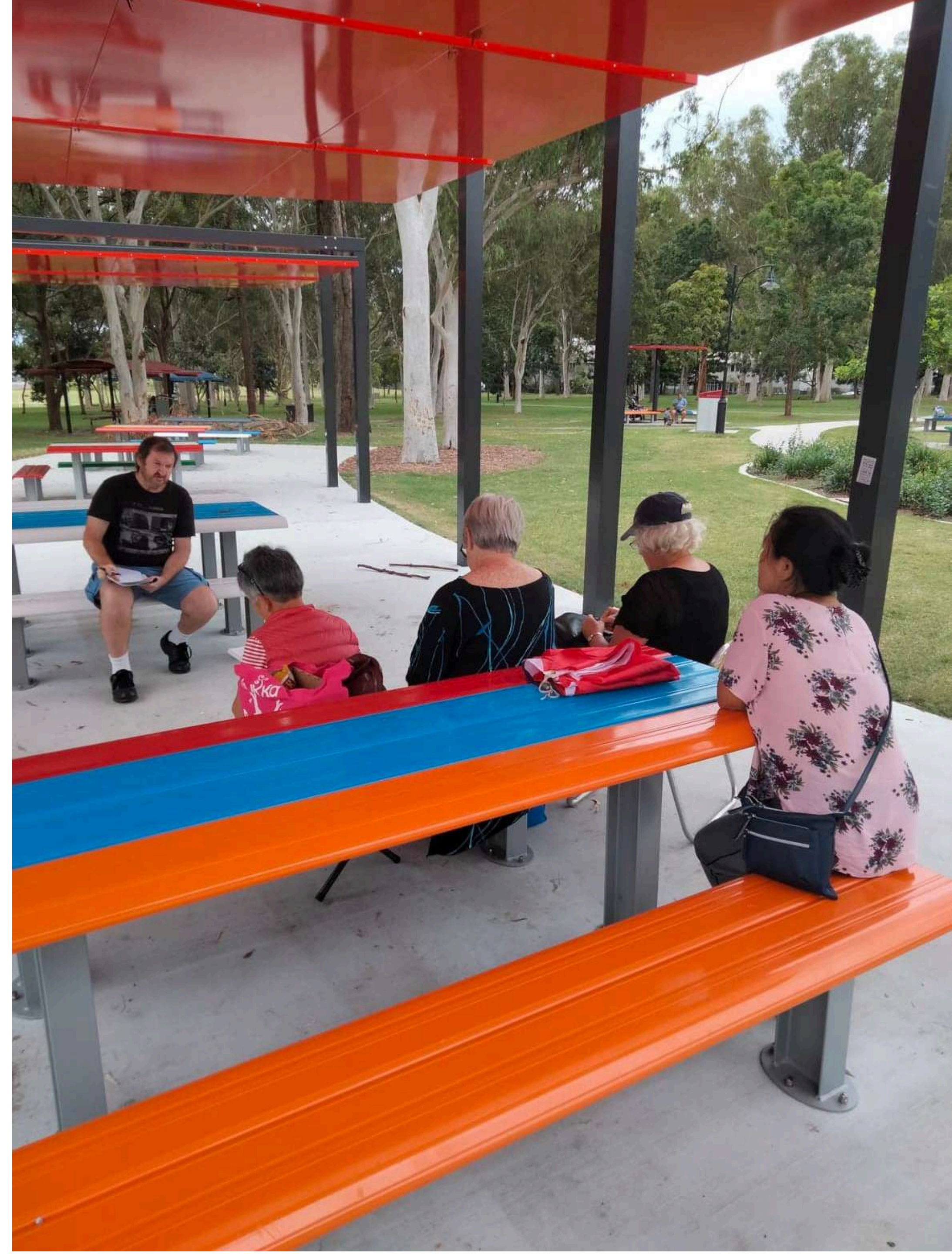
Barbara

Last Sunday on the way to Dae Jeon I saw 12 cars of fishermen, they were out in the lake, hepped up and gung ho to catch fish. The 12 cars reminded me of the 12 disciples as fishers of men. (See pics) Notice what was written in 1903 about Sunday. "We must try to remove their prejudice against the Bible Sabbath..... At one time, while I was in Australia, those in charge of our school at Avondale came to me, saying: "What shall we do? The officers of the law have been commissioned to arrest those working on Sunday." I said: "It will be very easy to avoid that difficulty. Give Sunday to the Lord as a day for doing missionary work. Take the students out to hold meetings in different places, and to do medical missionary work. They will find the people at home, and will have a splendid opportunity to present the truth. This way of spending Sunday is always acceptable to the Lord." {April 14, 1903}



That morning in DaeJeon went to one home and a young man answered the door, so showed him my books, he said my wife has the money and she is out somewhere and I just have credit cards , then he said let go see in the house, he left me alone standing on his doorstep with the door open for about 2 minutes, then his help meet Mrs came around the corner from wherever she had been with her purse in her hand seeing a stranger at her door and the door open. She was a little bewildered. Whilst I was trying to explain and soothe her anxieties her husband came back and in a husband like way commanded her to give me 10,000 Won for the book. He wanted the book but she was hesitating and a one minute squabble ensued. I was tempted to speak but a still small voice said "pray". "We wrestle not against flesh and blood. Whenever a book is presented that will expose error, Satan is close by the side of the one to whom it is offered, and urges reasons why it should not be accepted." {CM 115.1}

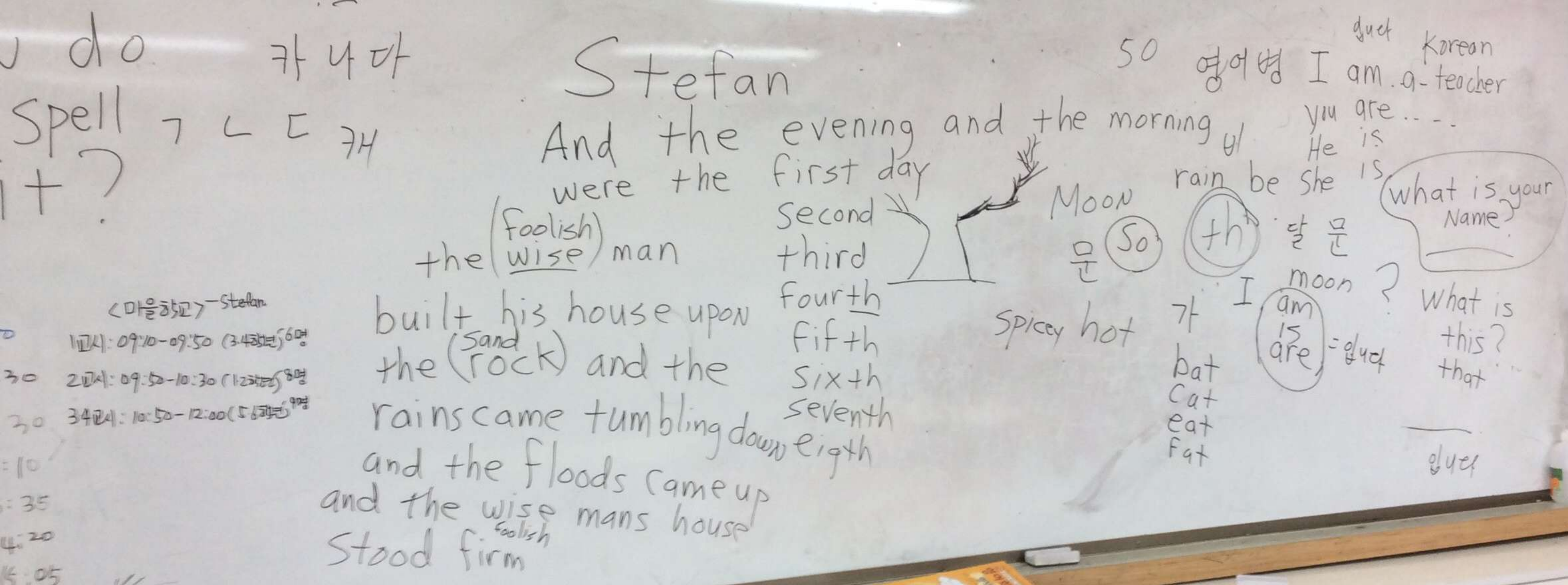
Praise God the angels prevailed. The book MB costs 5,000 so I gave them 2 books one for each of them. Then I remembered that I had some other books, an SL for 2,000 and a SC for 3,000 so went back and took one MB back and gave them the other 2 books.

Walked in front of a small market and there were 5 people so greeted the owner of the small shop with "Ahn Nyung ha say yo" she answered back "Ahn Nyung ha say yo" then another lady said "NO you should say hello" and "sssang kyu" with emphasis on the sssang. The Korean language has no "Th " sound so English words with a TH end up being SSSANG. Then she asked if I had a lover and that she studied at Harvard. So I realized that she was a little bit featherbrained. They all refused to buy a book. I noticed a tractor and talked for a while with the owner and asked if I could take a picture of his tractor. He said yea and later bought a book.

Showing them the books the couple refused saying we are Buddhists and layed the book on the table and they went out to shoot arrows. He was right handed and she was left handed. Mr Park was not really interested either, but when the couple walked out in the field to pick up their arrows I picked the one book off the table and put both books in the hand of Mr Park, then he said "since you walked all the way up here I better get your books"

Mission work is going well in Mohana GP in Odisha state.

A total of 40 members attended for Bible prophecy seminar on 31st today.

When I arrived here after a long journey, the house owners come to know that I am a Christian and they rejected to rent a room for me at 9.30 pm.

Then we looking for other places, but all rejected me because Christians are not allowed to stay in their house's. Praise the Lord, PR Bheem's house is very small, he has two children and a wife and himself. They sleep in a one room house, it's all they have.

I was happy to sleep outside his home, I enjoying natural air conditioning.

This village is suffering for lack of water, both drinking water and for using... they have to go to a small river side, both women and men for all their morning needs and washing and bathing, one side women and other side men.

At night, at 10 pm I went to the river side to have a bath. It's very Dangerous to go at night but i put my trust on Lord and went to have my bath.

And the same thing early in the morning for all physical needs.. behind the bushes. Ha. Ha..



We thought we can run meeting in the side of the hall, but it's very low high, so we face very hot in side of iron sheets shelter.

Then for second session, we rent a tent, out side, for second and third sessions we had wonderful meeting under tent.

Tomorrow we are going to run under the same tent. For drinking water the pastor's daughter goes half a kilometre and carries it on her head.

All these pastors and wives came from different Denominations and travelled 50 kms and 65 kms to attend this meeting, they started earlier in the morning to come down from mountains.

Today 20 Pastors were very happy with the message and positive response came...we had questions for an hour too.

Please continue to pray for Odisha mission and soon going Karnataka state mission work. Blessing.

3 catholic priest attended today's meeting.. they asked me lot of questions, they understand salvation plan.

Holy spirit is working in their hearts, because they asked me lot of questions.

We discussed in the morning session below subjects.

1. Ten commandments of GOD.
2. What is sin.

Afternoon session.

1. Trinity.
- 2 questions and answers.

Today Friday I will call for baptisms and already there are several people wanting baptism. One difficulty is finding water to baptise in, but the Lord will find a way.



On the second day 7 man Pastors and a Pastors Wife took the decision for baptism into one true God after understanding the Truth about GOD. All those pastors who have taken baptism, are independent pastors and are running small groups on mountain side.

They are very happy to work with RM, and willing to share the same Truth with others, they have taken Xerox copy's of the subjects to their church in Odia language.

Each one has a story to tell us how the Holy spirit guided them to come to the meetings from the mountain side which is a long distance away, all the Glory to Jesus Christ.

After 4 months again they invited me to teach more subjects and and some more will get ready for Baptism, because they said we need some time.

In every step i saw God is moving to guide me and the people, and every one enjoyed Breakfast, lunch, dinner.

I appreciate Brother, Neville, David and Michael for their prayers and encouragement in this mission.
