Below are our radio program groups;






From Stefan, South Korea

Last Sunday I decided to track with the counsel below and visit some out-of-the-way places.

"Books will reach those who can be reached in no other way,-those living far from any large settlement. I call these the byway hearers. To such ones our canvassers are to carry the books containing the message of Our canvassers are salvation. to be God's evangelists, going from house to house in out-of-theway places, and opening the Scriptures to those they meet. They will find those who are willing and anxious to learn from the Scriptures. . . . I greatly desire to do all in my power to reach those in the highways and the byways.--Letter 155, 1903.

The first 2 homes were not interested, then the 3rd house bought a GC, then met a group of bikers packing up in the morning getting ready to go. Had a nice spiritual talk with them and gave them some books containing the message of salvation.







Continuing farther down the road to another out-of-the-way place, the dog was barking and a Mr Suh came to the door with his chopsticks. He was eating lunch, seeing the clock time 12:11 reminds me of Rev 12:11. He insisted that I come in and have coffee, so went in and he made me some roasted barley tea. I asked him as a young boy if he had any religion in his home. He said "yea Toh Zhong religion", worshipping trees and rocks and the sun or anything in nature. Told him that instead of worshipping the sun we are called to worship the Creator who made the sun. He bought 3 books and I asked him to explain the picture on his wall.



Tuesday on the way to Ok Chun to do street preaching on market day, I felt impressed to go a little further down the road of the out-of-theway places, and came to a quaint out-of-theway restaurant. The lady that greeted me her family name was Kim which is the most common family name in Korea. But her name looked peculiar " lya". I asked her in Japanese are you Japanese? She said no, then asked in Chinese are you Chinese again she said no. Then she said I am Russian. There are many Koreans who were born in Russia. So I began to talk to her in Russian. She was very happy. Luckily there were no other customers and it was early morning. We sat down and began to talk. She is a Baptist and loves the Lord and has an 11 year old daughter. She has been in Korea for 11 years.

She bought a GC in Korean and gave me her email so I am sending her the GC in Russian a few paragraphs at a time copy and paste to whet and sharpen her spiritual appetite. I prayed for her and her daughter Hanna. After the prayer she said "Oh that is strange, this morning I was thinking I wish a Russian would come so I could talk with him and now you showed up" I then reminded her about our invisible angels.

We talked about Jesus and she was born the same year I was 3 months earlier, so I called her big sister, she was happy.
